Grimsby and Cleethorpes Model Engineering Society Charitable Incorporated Organisation Registered Charity Number 1179899 (England and Wales) The Grimsby and Cleethorpes Model Engineering Society endeavours to foster an enjoyment in model engineering for junior members. To this end, junior members will be encouraged to take part in the general maintenance and running of the club site at Waltham Windmill, but this is not compulsory.

The providing of miniature train rides for the public is one of the main sources of income for the society. This requires several members to provide locomotives and carry out the duties required for the running of the trains on a voluntary basis. Junior members will be instructed in general site and track maintenance and the preparation of engines and coaching stock for the provision of rides. Each junior member will be provided with a log book, listing the various tasks to be carried out. Junior members will be given the opportunity drive both steam and electric locomotives, along with operating various machine tools under instruction, but only if supervision is available. The junior member will be instructed in each task and when sufficiently competent will be allowed to perform the tasks with minimal supervision. The logbook will be signed when instruction and competency checking have been completed. This will allow other members to assess which tasks the junior member can carry out and the level of supervision required. There are number of tasks that the junior member will not be able to undertake until reaching the age of 16 years. These tasks will include the handling of money, the operating of machinery whilst unsupervised and driving engines that are hauling trains carrying the general public.

All junior members will require some level of supervision. If there are not enough senior members to provide adequate supervision, then the junior member will not be able to participate in the sites activities at that time. It should be noted that some members would not wish to take on the role of supervisor.

The junior member's good conduct on site is extremely important from both the point of safety along with maintaining good relations with the visiting public. This will be one of the main factors in determining the level of supervision required.

This form applies to junior membership applications where the parent or guardian is not a member of the Society, or where the parent or guardian does attend the club activities at all times that the child is present. The Society is obliged to determine that lawful consent has been given for the child to participate in activities of the Society. If the parent or guardian does not agree with the statements below, then the child shall not be eligible for membership as an independent member. However in such circumstances the child may still participate if the parent or guardian obtains a family membership and attends at all times with the child.

Please be aware that, for insurance reasons, no person appointed by the parent or guardian may accompany child on Society activities unless that person is also a member. Please be aware that Junior Membership is only granted as a probationary membership for the first twelve months.
